WHEREAS, amended budgets have been submitted to the Board of Supervisors to change line items within those budgets; and

WHEREAS, Appropriations were made to the departments for the FY 17 accordance with Section 331.434(6), Code of Iowa, by the Board of Supervisors by Resolution 17-07 on March 13, 2017;

WHEREAS, the amended budgets require that the appropriations also be amended; and there are sufficient resources available without increases in taxes for FY ending June 30, 2018.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors, Ida County, Iowa, that the said budget revisions, herewith attached and on file in the Auditor's Office, and the Appropriation revision as set forth below, be approved, and the Auditor directed to correct the records accordingly.

County Engineer Jeff Williams presented 3 Utility Permits for NIPCO for overhead construction over 330th St./D54 between Section 28 & 33 and Section 16 & 21 in Hayes Township and Section 15 and 14 of Grant Township over Jasper Ave./M15. Schubert moved to approve and authorize the Chair to sign said permits. Drey seconded the motion and it carried, all voting Aye.

Schubert moved to approve an agreement and authorize the Chair to sign for professional final design services for the reconstruction of M31 from IA Highway 175 to U.S. Highway 20, not to exceed \$98,000. Leonard seconded the motion and it carried, all voting Aye.

Discussion was held on D15 and Belly Dump Trailers. Various construction and

personnel staffing were discussed.

Drey moved to approve and authorize the Chair to sign the Landfill Financial Assurance Report Form for FY17. Schubert seconded the motion and it carried, all voting Aye.

A motion by Schubert and seconded by Drey to approve the following Conservation Seasonal Employees: Ivan Sandler-\$11.00 per hour, effective mid-April; Randy Nielsen-\$10.00 per hour, effective April 30th and Kasha Shear-Naturalist Assistant at \$9.50 per hour from mid-May to the end of July. Motion carried, all voting Aye.

A motion to amend the agenda to include the approval of correspondence with regards to the dedication of a bridge on Highway 20 over the Maple River in memory of former U.S. Army Sgt. Dillon Donald Naslund, a fallen Veteran from Galva, IA, to Congressman Steve King. Schubert seconded the motion and it carried, all voting Aye. Schubert moved to approve said correspondence and Drey seconded the motion and it carried, all voting Aye.

A claim in the amount of \$305.00 was approved from the Assessor Fund for an Iowa Assessment & Taxation Review class.

The Board acknowledged receipt of manure management plans from Lundell #4/Brad and Sarah Lundell; B & D Dairy/Brit Baxley; Jeff Schroeder #68331; Fredco, Inc.-Joe's Place/Brian Friedrichsen.

There being no further business, the Board adjourned to meet again at 8:00 a.m., Monday June 4, 2018, or on call of the Chair.
