Ida County Board of Supervisors

IDA GROVE, IOWA JUNE 15, 2021

The Board of Supervisors convened in adjourned session, members present Chair Raymond Drey, Rhett Leonard and Creston Schubert.

Minutes of the meeting held May 25, 2021, were read and approved.

County Engineer Jeff Williams declined a closed session for the purpose of his annual review. Schubert moved and Leonard seconded a motion to approve and authorize the Chair to sign the FY-22 contract in the amount of \$124,484. Motion carried, all voting Aye.

The Engineer informed the Board that there will be a bid letting on June 29, 2021, at 2:00 p.m. for Repainting Pavement Markings on parts of D15 and M31 and Micro-surfacing parts of L51 and D15.

Discussion was held on land-owners changing Right of Way markers.

Leonard moved and Schubert seconded a motion to approve the purchase of a 2022 Alpha HD 110 HDG-SF Lowboy from Hawk Equipment Company in Sioux City for \$70,480. Schubert seconded the motion and it carried, all voting Aye.

Dan Conover, Custodian, declined a closed session for the purpose of his annual review. Schubert moved and Leonard seconded a motion to increase his salary to \$19.93 per hour, effective July 1, 2021. Motion carried, all voting Aye.

Sheriff Wade Harriman was present to request a salary increase of \$1.50 per hour for the Civil Deputy position for FY-22 due to extra responsibilities. After much discussion, it was the consensus of the Board not to approve said increase.

Deputy Sheriff Corey Trucke was present to discuss the Alpha Wireless Quote for a panic alarm system. Schubert moved to approve and authorize the Chair to sign the base quote in the amount of \$10,878.66 for 10 panic buttons with the option of adding more buttons if necessary. Leonard seconded the motion and it carried, all voting Aye.

Leonard moved to approve a bid from Ladwig Construction in the amount of \$1,500 for a cement slab to install a Memorial Bench and a flagpole. Schubert seconded a motion and it carried, all voting Aye.

Discussion was held on a proposed salary for Part-time Sheriff Sergeant and EMS Director Corey Trucke. The proposed salary will be \$64,566 which will be split in half for each department. The salary will include extra compensation for a supervisory position and holiday compensation. The position will be based on a 40-hour work week. The position will be considered exempt from overtime/comp. time and no extra compensation for on-call services or medical investigator services.

Treasurer Traci Riessen informed the Board that Sherri Oberreuter-Driver's License, had resigned, effective June 30, 2021. Traci reported that she has placed an ad for the position and has contacted the surrounding counties to see if they had any available staff to issue licenses until a replacement is trained which could take 1-2 months. Schubert moved and Leonard seconded a motion to approve said resignation. Motion carried, all voting Aye.

Leonard moved to approve Resolution 21-19 FY-22 Appropriations. Schubert seconded the motion and it carried, all voting Aye.

A motion by Leonard and seconded by Schubert to approve Resolution 21-20: Transferring \$17,653.15 from the Post Closure Fund to the Rural Basic Landfill Fund. Motion carried, all voting Aye.

Schubert moved and Leonard seconded a motion to approve Resolution 21-21, transferring \$105,156 from General Basic and \$1,046,391 from Rural Basic to Secondary Roads for FY-22. Motion carried, all voting Aye.

A motion by Schubert to approve Resolution 21-22 Amending the FY-21 Appropriations by \$600 to the Debt Service Fund. Leonard seconded the motion and it carried, all voting Aye.

Schubert moved to approve the FY-22 Salaries of Elected Officials Deputies and Clerks. Leonard seconded the motion and it carried, all voting Aye.

A motion by Leonard and seconded by Schubert to approve and authorize the Chair to sign a contract with Solutions for IT services in the amount of \$18,774 for FY-22. Motion carried, all voting Aye.

Schubert moved to approve the Clerk of Court reports for February through May of 2021. Leonard seconded the motion and it carried, all voting Aye.

Action with regards to the 28E Ida County Public Safety and Communications was tabled until July.

A motion by Schubert and seconded by Leonard to approve and authorize the Chair to sign a 28E agreement with Rolling Hills Community Service Region-Adding Humboldt and Pocahontas Counties. Motion carried, all voting Aye.

Leonard moved and Drey seconded a motion to amend the agenda to include action with regards to an Emergency Action Plan from Ed Sohm, Safety Director. Motion carried, all voting Aye.

A motion by Leonard and seconded by Schubert to approve an Emergency Action Plan. Motion carried, all voting Aye.

Leonard moved to approve Resolution 21-24 an interfund loan transferring \$10,000 from General Basic to the General Supplemental Fund. Drey seconded the motion and it carried, all voting Aye.
