CONSIDERATION OF RESOLUTION 23-15

NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION TO DECLARE EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES TO BE AN ESSENTIAL SERVICE FOR IDA COUNTY, IA

The Ida County Board of Supervisors approved a public hearing on June 27, 2023 at 10:30 a.m. in the Magistrate Court Room, 401 Moorehead St., Ida Grove, IA for the first of three hearings to consider Resolution 23-15. To declare emergency medical services (EMS) to be an essential county service as authorized by Iowa Code Section 422D.1

At that time and place, the proposal to consider adoption of a Resolution 23-15 that will allow for an election to be offered for voter approval of local income surtax option or ad valorem property tax not to exceed \$.75 per thousands of taxable valuation for EMS and the creation of a county emergency medical services system advisory council to assist in researching and assessing the service needs of the county and guide implementation of the same under Iowa Code 422D.1. Details of Resolution 23-15 are on file and may be reviewed in the Auditor's Office or on the idacounty.iowa.gov website.
