PUBLIC NOTICE ANTIDegradation ALTERNATIVES ANALYSIS FOR THE CITY OF HOLSTEIN, IOWA

Notice Date: Nov. 16, 2022

Notice is hereby given that the City of Holstein, Iowa has completed a draft antidegradation alternative analysis (AAA) for discharge of treated wastewater into Unnamed Creek. The action being considered is upgrading the existing lagoons to aerated lagoons and constructing a submerged air growth reactor (SAGR) with ultraviolet (UV) disinfection to upgrade the City's existing lagoon system. Unnamed Creek is protected for Class A2 secondary contact recreational and B(WW-2) warm water beneficial uses.

Anyone wishing to comment on the proposed treatment alternative must do so in writing within 30

days of the date shown at the top of this notice. Comments may be submitted to the City Administrator by hand delivery to: 119 S. The City will submit a summary of comments received and the City's responses to the Iowa Department of Natural Resources with the final alternative analysis subject to IDNR review and approval.
