Galva-Holstein **Board of Education** July 11, 2022 Regular Board Meeting

The Galva-Holstein Board of Education met in joint regular session with the Schaller-Crestland Board of Education on Monday. July 11, 2022 at 7 p.m. in the Galva Holstein Media Center Board members present: Grant Aschinger, Tyler Gebers, Don Kalin, Jamie Whitmer, Matthew Wittrock and Jeff Witzke. Absent: Beth Schossow

Administrators: Superintendent

Visitors present: Suttvn Aschinger.

Call to order: President Whitmer at 7:01 p.m.

Motion by Wittrock, second by Kalin to approve agenda as presented. Motion carried 6-0.

Motion by Wittrock, second by Aschinger to approve the minutes of the June 13, 2022 board meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Wittrock, second by Aschinger to approve bills as presented. Wittrock reviewed bills prior to meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Financial statements were presented with approval completion of audit and state reporting.

Motion by Witzke, second by Kalin to approve the hiring of Jennifer Stille as an administrative assistant, Julie Johnson as a Spanish room proctor, Jensen as an assistant volleyball coach, Hayley Seuntjens as a JVR volleyball coach, Keely Dutler as an assistant girls' basketball coach and Katelyn Johnson as an instructional aide. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Wittrock, second by Witzke to approve the milk bid submitted by Anderson Erickson Dairy for the 2022-23 school year. Motion carried 6-0.

Motion by Wittrock, second by Kalin to approve the recommended fees as presented for the 2022-23 school year. Motion carried 6-0.
Director Aschinger introduced

the following Resolution and moved its adoption. Director Witzke seconded the motion to adopt. The roll was called, and the vote was:

The President declared the Resolution adopted as follows: RESOLUTION ORDERING

ELECTION ON THE QUESTION
OF CONTINUING TO LEVY AND IMPOSE A VOTER APPROVED PHYSICAL PLANT AND EQUIPMENT PROPERTY TAX AND INCOME SURTAX.

WHEREAS, this Board has determined that an election should be called on the question of continuing to levy and impose a voter approved physical plant and equipment property tax and income NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS

RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE GALVA-HOLSTEIN COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT, IN THE COUNTIES OF IDA, CHEROKEE, BUENA VISTA AND SAC, STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. That an election is called of the qualified electors of the Galva-Holstein Community School District, in the Counties of Ida, Cherokee, Buena Vista and Sac, State of Iowa, on Tuesday, September 13, 2022. The following Proposition is approved, and the Secretary is authorized and directed to submit and file the Proposition for the Ballot with the Ida County Commissioner of Elections at least 46 days prior to the election.

PROPOSITION:

Shall the Board of Directors of the Galva-Holstein Community School District, in the Counties of Ida, Cherokee, Buena Vista and Sac State of Iowa, for the purpose of

purchasing and improving grounds; constructing schoolhouses or buildings and opening roads to schoolhouses or buildings; purchasing of buildings; purchase lease-purchase of technology and equipment; paying debts contracted for the erection or construction of schoolhouses or buildings, not including interest on bonds; procuring or acquisition of libraries; repairing, remodeling, reconstructing, improving, or expanding the schoolhouses or buildings and additions to existing schoolhouses; expenditures for conservation: renting facilities under Iowa Code Chapter 28E; purchasing transportation transporting equipment for transporting students; lease purchase option agreements for school buildings for equipment; equipment authorized by law; or for any purpose or purposes now or hereafter authorized by law, be authorized for a period of ten (10) years to levy and impose a voter-approved physical plant and equipment tax of not exceeding One Dollar Thirty-Four Cents (\$1.34) per One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) of assessed valuation of the taxable property within the school district, and be authorized annually, in combination, as determined by the board, to levy a physical plant and equipment property tax upon all the taxable property within the school district commencing with the levy of property taxes for collection in the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024, and to impose a physical plant and equipment income surtax upon the state individual income tax of each individual income taxpayer resident in the school district on December 31 for each calendar year commencing with calendar year 2023, or each year thereafter. That the notice of the election and ballot form used at the election

shall be prepared in accordance with the provisions of the Iowa Code and Iowa Administrative Rules.

Section 2. Ida County. Iowa is the Controlling County for this

Section 3. That the Election Board for the Voting Precinct or precincts be appointed by the County Commissioner of Elections for each County conducting an election, not less than 15 days before the election.

Section 4. The Commissioner of Elections for each County conducting an election is requested and directed to make publication of the Notice of Election at least once, not less than four days nor more than twenty days prior to the election, in a newspaper that meets the requirements of Iowa Code

Section 49.53(2).

Section 5. That the County
Commissioner of Elections for each County conducting an election shall prepare all ballots and election registers and other supplies as necessary for the proper and legal conduct of this election and the Secretary of the Board is authorized and directed to cooperate with these Commissioners of Elections in the preparation of the necessary proceedings.

Section 6. That the Secretary is directed to file a certified copy of this Resolution in the Office of the County Commissioner of Elections of the Controlling County to constitute the "written notice" to the County Commissioner of Elections of the election date, required to be given by the governing body under the provisions of Iowa Code Chapter 47.

Superintendent Bisenius updated the boards on professional development that he is currently engaged in, as well as informing the boards of utilizing GovDeals for advertising older items the school no longer uses and would like to sell or dispose of. He also informed the boards of a teacher requesting

to begin a FCA Huddle group at the high school

Motion by Aschinger, second by Kalin to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried unanimously.
