Notice is hereby given to the eligible electors and qualified voters of the County of Ida, State of Iowa, that the Primary Election will be held on Tuesday, June 2, 2026. The polls will open at 7 a.m. and close at 8 p.m.
Pre-registered voters are required to provide an approved form of identification at the polling place before receiving and casting a regular ballot. Voters who are not pre-registered, such as voters registering to vote on election day, and voters changing precincts must also provide proof of residence. A voter who is unable to provide an approved form of identification (or prove residence if required) may 1) have the voter's identity/residence attested to by another registered voter in the precinct, 2) prove identity and residence using Election Day Registration documents, or 3) cast a provisional ballot and provide proof of identity/residence at the county auditor's office by noon on Monday, June 8, 2026. Election Day Registrant attestors must provide an approved form of identification.
