**June 8, 2026
Regular Board Meeting**
The Galva-Holstein Board of Education met in regular session June 8, 2026 with the Schaller-Crestland Board of Education at the Schaller-Crestland Media Center at 7 p.m. with the following board members present: Grant Aschinger, Tara Ruble, Beth Schossow and Tyler Vohs. Absent: Jamie Whitmer, Matthew Wittrock and Tyler Vohs.
Administration: Superintendent Adam Bisenius.
Visitors present: Corvin Griffin.
Call to order: 7 p.m.
Motion by Ruble second by Vohs to appoint Vice President Aschinger as acting president for the June 8 board meeting. Motion carried 4-0.
Motion by Vohs, second by Schossow to approve agenda as presented. Motion carried 4-0.
There was no public comment.
Motion by Schossow, second by Ruble to approve the 3 sets of

minutes presented. Motion carried unanimously.
Motion by Ruble, second by Schossow to approve bills as presented. Motion carried unanimously. (Aschinger reviewed bills prior to meeting.)
Motion by Vohs, second by Schossow to approve financials for May 2026 as presented. Motion carried 4-0.
In principal reports, Bisenius informed the boards about ongoing summer school for elementary students at both districts.
Motion by Schossow, second by Ruble to approve contracts for Brian Wilken, Head Football Coach; Nathan Conover, Tyler Wingert, and Adam Bisenius as assistant football coaches; Wade Harriman as volunteer football coach; Monica Bloyer, Head Volleyball Coach; Steph Wandrey and Carly Murphy as assistant volleyball coaches; Katie Tesch as Head Cross Country Coach and Chance Downs as assistant cross country coach. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Schossow, second by Ruble to approve the school fees for the 26-27 school year as presented. Motion carried unanimously.
Discussion and vote on approving the breakdown insurance agreement with SU Insurance was tabled until the cost for 26-27 premium is received.
Motion by Vohs, second by Schossow to renew the 5-year concessions beverage contract with Coca-Cola. Motion carried 4-0.
Motion by Ruble second by Schossow to share the girls wrestling program with Alta-Aurelia and OABCIG for the 26-27 wrestling season. Motion carried unanimously.
Motion by Schossow, second by Ruble to approve technology purchases up to \$70,000 for the 26-27 school year. Motion carried unanimously.
Motion by Ruble, second by Vohs to adopt a resolution to fix the date of sale of approximately \$6.1 million school infrastructure sales, services and use tax revenue bonds series 2026,

approve electronic bidding procedures and approve the official statement. The roll was called, and the vote was: Ayes: Aschinger, Ruble, Schossow and Vohs. Nays: None. Motion carried 4-0.
In his superintendent report, Bisenius relayed to the boards that he would be meeting with other conference superintendents to discuss options for 8th graders involved in high school sports. He also relayed that OABCIG's board would be voting on whether or not to offer soccer as a high school sport. He updated the boards on the move of the Early building's contents to Schaller as well as construction progress at the Holstein site.
Motion by Vohs, second by Ruble to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried 4-0.
