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## **PROCEEDINGS: HOLSTEIN CITY COUNCIL • MAY 13 MINUTES / CLAIMS / REVENUE**

Tuesday, May 13, 2025 A regular meeting of the Holstein City Council was held on Tuesday May 13, 2025 in City Hall. Mayor Kathy Breyfogle called the meeting to order at 5 p.m. with the pledge of allegiance and a roll as follows: Bonnie Stevenson, Jamison Voss, Marcus Prell, Terri Schimmer, and Christine Wiese. A motion was made by Councilperson Wiese and seconded by Councilperson Voss approving the consent agenda including agenda, Minutes of April 22, 2025, Regular Council Meeting, Treasurer's Report, Balance Sheet, Revenue Report, Budget Report, Wage Report, and Claims, Approval of Holstein Country Club Class C Liquor License, Midwest Deli Class C Liquor License, LV Petroleum Class B Liquor License, and Class C Kinderfest, Approval of Cigarette/ Tobacco permit for A&A Food & Fuel LLC, Casey's, Dollar General, Holstein Super Market, LV Petroleum, and Spirits, Stogies & Stuff.
